Mature Age Entry

The Mature Age Entry Scheme is an alternative admission route for prospective students not in possession of a Grade 12 Certificate or for those with a Grade 12 Certificate who does not fulfil the minimum admission criteria based on Grade 12.

Candidates aspiring for admission to NTIT's study programmes through the Mature Age Entry Scheme must satisfy the following conditions:

• They should be at least 25 years old on the first day of the academic year in which admission is sought;

- They should preferably have successfully completed junior secondary education or senior secondary education or both.
- They must have proof of at least 2-5 years relevant work experience relating to the proposed study programme.




5 of the 13 Important Functions of a Nurse

What is a nurse?

A nurse is a medical professional who provides general patient care and triage. Nurses usually work with a team of other medical professionals, such as physicians and other healthcare specialists. Nurses can work in a wide variety of environments, including:

- Hospitals
- Clinics
- Doctors' offices
- Schools
- Correctional facilities
- Homeless shelters
- Rehabilitation centers
- Senior care homes





4 Elements Of Nursing

Four major concepts are frequently interrelated and fundamental to nursing theory: person, environment, health, and nursing. These four are collectively referred to as metaparadigm for nursing.



Environment

Environment (or situation) is defined as the internal and external surroundings that affect the client. It includes all positive or negative conditions that affect the patient, the physical environment, such as families, friends, and significant others, and the setting for where they go for their healthcare.

Person



Health

Health is defined as the degree of wellness or well-being that the client experiences. It may have different meanings for each patient, the clinical setting, and the health care provider.



The nurse's attributes, characteristics, and actions provide care on behalf of or in conjunction with the client. There are numerous definitions of nursing, though nursing scholars may have difficulty agreeing on its exact definition. The ultimate goal of nursing theories is to improve patient care.
